Here are a few ways to reinforce what your child is learning about respecting adults:

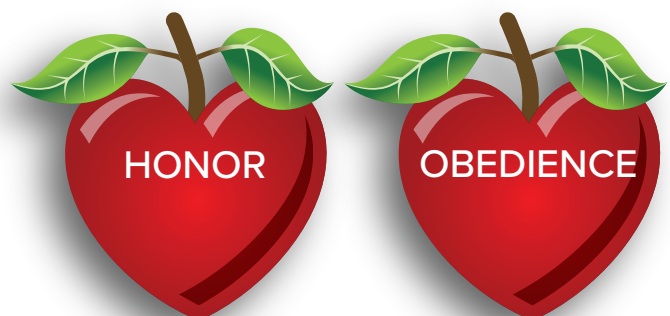
- Discuss the importance of showing respect and appreciation for adults in your community.
